



## PRODUCER OBLIGATIONS: INDUSTRIAL BATTERIES

Harland Simon UPS Ltd is registered as a Producer of Industrial batteries on the NPWD database. Registration number NPWD294743.

Under the Waste Batteries and Accumulators Regulations 2009, Harland Simon UPS Ltd are obliged to take back waste industrial batteries, supplied to an end user, for treatment and recycling.

This requirement is free of charge in any calendar year Harland Simon UPS Ltd place new industrial batteries on the market.

Waste batteries can be taken back from end users, within a reasonable time, and within the compliance period, if:

- The end user has been supplied by the Producer with new industrial batteries during the compliance period;
- The end user has not been able to return, for any reason, waste industrial batteries to the original Producer;
- The waste product is of the same chemistry as the new industrial batteries that the Producer placed on the market for the first time in the UK in the compliance period, or in any of the preceding 3 years.

Harland Simon UPS Ltd has, during this compliance period and the preceding 3 years, placed Industrial Valve Regulated Lead (Pb) Acid batteries (VRLA) on to the UK market.

Please note that nothing in the regulations prevents a producer of Industrial batteries from concluding an agreement under which the parties to the agreement make arrangements to finance the net costs of the collection, treatment and recycling of waste products which may differ from the arrangements provided for under the regulations.
